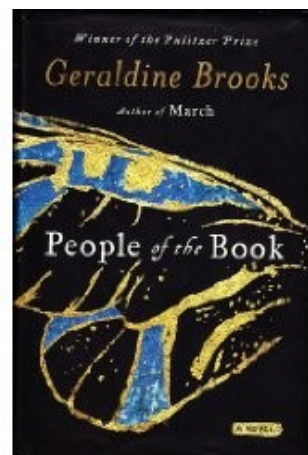

Faith at Home: Faith discussion starters for the whole family.
How is the Bible different from other books?
 Every book is written for a purpose. The writer wants to teach something, entertain, make someone laugh, or show something beautiful (can you name books that serve each of these purposes?) Like other books the Bible was written for a purpose. The Bible's purpose is, "so that you will put your faith in Jesus as the Messiah and the Son of God. If you have faith in him, you will have true life". (John 20:31)
In the Bible there are four different books called Gospels. Each one is about the life of Jesus and each one is slightly different from the other. Read Matthew 1:18-2:12 and Luke 2:1-21. How are they different and the same?

3 C's of God's Teachers
